## **Eligibility**

Students must be in grades 6-12 and one of the following must apply:

- Be currently enrolled in a Davidson County, Lexington City, or Thomasville City school
- Be currently enrolled in a private school within Davidson County
- Be currently enrolled in a registered homeschool within Davidson County

Limit 2 pieces total per student. There is no limit per class, teacher or grade but In order to curate the finest collection for our exhibition, we kindly request that each teacher submits the best work while avoiding any duplicates. This will enable us to showcase a diverse and captivating selection of art, highlighting the unique talents of students in our county. Your cooperation in making these thoughtful selections is greatly appreciated as we aim to present a truly exceptional and inspiring exhibition.

### <u>Criteria</u>

The gallery will accept:

- 2-D Art: Watercolor, Pen & Ink, Photography, Paper, Tempera, Pencil, Acrylic, Printmaking, Mixed Media, Digital, Other. 2-D work may not exceed 16"x 24".
- 3-D Art: Ceramics, Glass, Mosaic, Fiber, Wood, Paper Mache', Metal, Other.

Not Accepted: Modeling clay artwork Lego or kit creations Works considered too fragile for transport/installation Collaborative/group projects Glass frames

All Artwork must meet the following Guidelines:

- Entries must be mounted.
- Entries must be labeled on the front of the art (using the label provided)
- Adhesive will be added to the back of entries for mounting.
- Entries must be no larger than 16" X 24"
- Teachers are responsible for ensuring only original images are included

\*\*If not adequately prepared for display, artwork will be withdrawn from the exhibition. Arts Davidson County reserves the right to refuse any submission that it deems unacceptable.

#### <u>Awards</u>

All student participants receive a Certificate of Excellence for their entries. Plaques are awarded for 1st and 2nd Place recognition by grade ranges and artistic medium category. The exhibit and a reception for students, their families, teachers, and the public is free and is held at Arts | Theatre 202 in Lexington.
